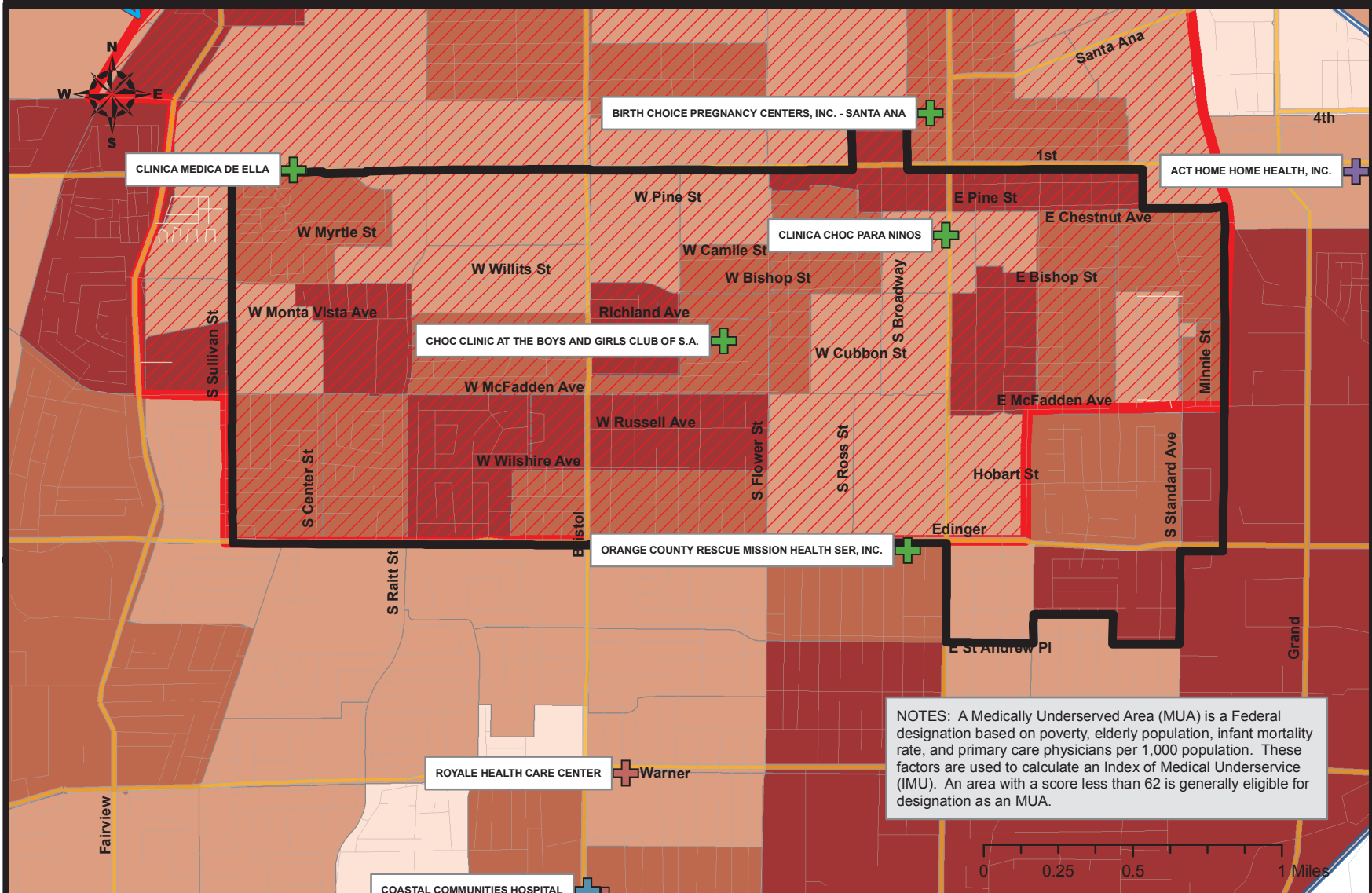


Medically Underserved Areas, Licensed Healthcare Facilities, and Child Population (<18) Building Healthy Communities (BHC) Intervention Area, Santa Ana, CA



NOTES: A Medically Underserved Area (MUA) is a Federal designation based on poverty, elderly population, infant mortality rate, and primary care physicians per 1,000 population. These factors are used to calculate an Index of Medical Underservice (IMU). An area with a score less than 62 is generally eligible for designation as an MUA.
