

## **Annual Greenville Banning Inner-Coastal & Watershed Clean-up at Centennial Park on Saturday, September 20, 2008**

Approximately 100 volunteers from local high schools (Lorin Griset, Godinez, Segerstrom, Valley, and Saddleback) and from the surrounding Windsor Village, Windsor Village North, and Centennial Park neighborhoods participated in the Annual Inner-Coastal Watershed Cleanup at Centennial Park along the Greenville-Banning Channel area located on the eastern stretch of Centennial Park adjacent to Fairview St. About 800 lbs. of trash were removed. The year's event was made possible by committed residents and youth volunteers who continue the tradition of renewing community pride and improving the appearance and sanitation of their local park and watershed. Lunch for the volunteers was provided by a resident of the Windsor Village Neighborhood Association.
