Research and Evaluation

In the 2007-08 academic school year, SAUSD had 1 dropout at the intermediate level. This student was from Lathrop Intermediate. At the high school level, SAUSD had 236 dropouts. The majority came from Century (93) and Valley (105). This data is collected from the CSIS submission in October 2009. Dropout rates, as calculated by CDE, are not currently available for the 2007-08 academic year.

In the 2007-08 academic school year, 47% of SAUSD students passed the ELA section of the CAHSEE and 51% passed the Math section. However, 100% of CAHSEE test takers from Middle College passed both sections of the test. At Segerstrom, 95% passed the ELA section and 92% passed the Math section. These include the combined administrations throughout 2007-08 and also include all grade levels (10, 11, and 12).

In 2007-08, 29 of 35 Elementary schools showed a higher percentage of students scoring proficient or above on the ELA CST (when compared to 2006-07 CST) and 27 Elementary schools showed a higher percentage of students scoring proficient or above on the Math CST. 9 of 9 Intermediate schools showed a higher percentage of students scoring at proficient or above on the ELA CST. Carr and MacArthur had more than 80% of their Algebra I CST test takers score proficient or above. 1 of 10 High schools showed a higher percentage of students scoring proficient or above on the ELA CST; it was Century. At the high school level, AYP is based on CAHSEE and CAPA, not CST.
