BASIC CITY COUNCIL MEETING INFORMATION

CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT

The people of the City of Santa Ana, at an election held on February 5, 2008, approved an amendment to the City Charter of the City of Santa Ana which established the Code of Ethics and Conduct for elected officials and members of appointed boards, commissions, and committees to assure public confidence. AGENDA DESCRIPTIONS

The agenda descriptions provide the public with a general summary of the items of business to be considered by the Council. The Council is not limited in any way by the **Recommended Action** and may take any action which the council deems to be appropriate on an agenda item. Except as otherwise provided by law, no action shall be taken on any item not listed on the agenda. Late materials received following the posting of the agenda will be available for viewing in the Council meeting location during the session.

PUBLIC INPUT

AGENDA ITEMS – Members of the public shall be given three (3) minutes to address the City Council on any and all matters contained on the City Council agenda as well as the agendas of any of the City's related agencies scheduled at the same time; Members of the public shall also be given three (3) minutes to address the City Council for each duly noticed hearing, unless the matter is continued prior to taking public testimony; members of the public shall also be provided an opportunity to address the Council on issues of public interest within the subject matter jurisdiction of the City Council. All requests to speak shall be submitted in writing by submitting a speaker card to the Clerk of the Council. No requests to speak shall be accepted after the public comment session begins without permission of the presiding officer.

CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters listed under the consent calendar are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion without discussion unless a member of the Council "pulls" an item(s) from the consent calendar for a separate vote.
