**FREE** to Santa Ana Residents

Ride must end at Pacific Electric Festival site at 11:00 a.m. (McFadden & Orange Ave.)

**Robust Ride** start from Thornton Park (1801 W. Segerstrom) 7 miles roundtrip  
**Classic Ride** start from Monroe Elementary (417 E. Central Ave - Next to Delhi Park) 2.5 miles roundtrip

Both rides can start between 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. - parking available at both sites

Age requirement: 10+ years. Children are allowed to ride tandem with an adult. Anyone participating on the bike ride must sign a City of Santa Ana Release of Liability form. If you are under the age of 18 a parent must sign for you.
