Registration Policies

1. Class applications will be processed on a first-come, first- served basis.
2. There will be no further registration taken for the current session after the second week of class.
3. Payments must be made by check, cash, or money order only.
4. You will not receive a confirmation if accepted into a class. However, you will be contacted if there is a problem processing your request for a class or if a class is full or canceled.
5. If you pay by check, you expressly authorize the City of Santa Ana or its agents, should the check be dishonored or returned for whatever reason, to electronically debit your bank account on which the check is drawn for the amount of the check, plus a \$25 processing fee.
6. Classes will be canceled if minimum enrollment is not met.
7. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Agency has the right to cancel any and all classes, activities or excursions, without advance notice.

Refund Policies

1. Fees for one-day classes, workshops, activities, programs and tours are non-refundable.
2. If a class is canceled or is full a refund will automatically be mailed to the customer.

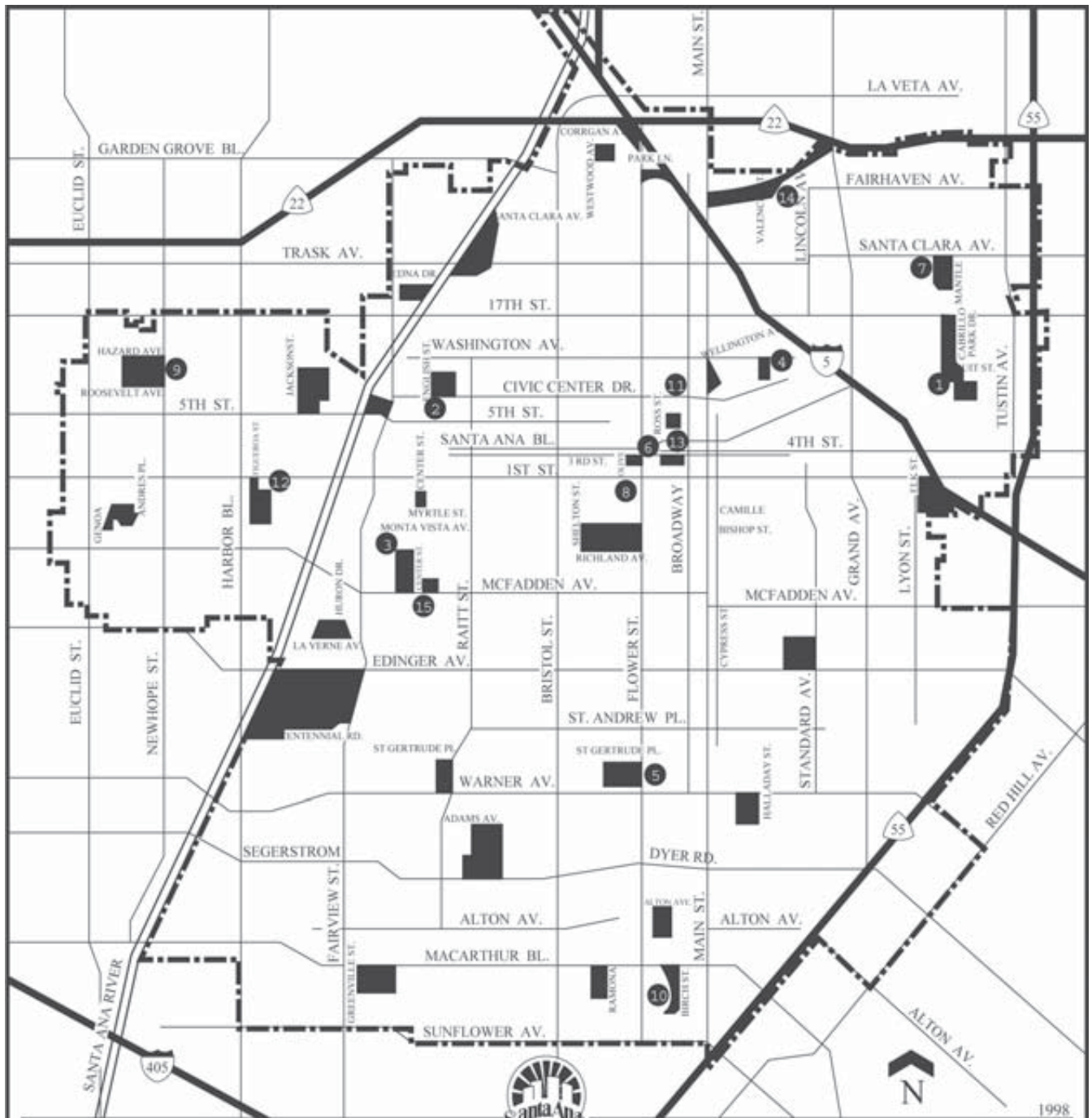
