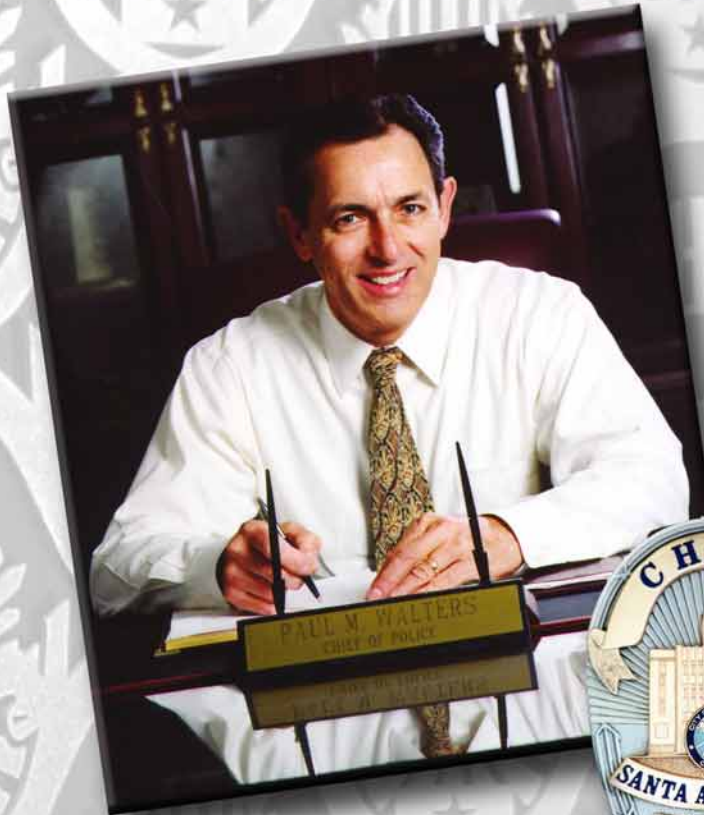

# ***ADVANCED GANG INVESTIGATION***

**November 16-18, 2010**  
**(24 HOURS)**

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This three-day course is devoted specifically to intelligence gathering, investigating, and prosecuting gang-related crimes utilizing California's "Street Terrorism Enforcement and Prevention Act." Upon completion of this course, students will have the information to successfully investigate gang-related crimes as well as possess a working knowledge of 186.22 of the California Penal Code. The primary instructors for this course are Derrick Watkins and Richard Ashby. Derrick is a retired gang detective from the Santa Ana Police Department and prior to Santa Ana; Derrick was assigned to a gang detail in LA County. He has dedicated nine years of his career to criminal street gangs and is a court recognized expert in Hispanic and White Supremacist gangs. Derrick is currently instructing Criminal Justice courses at Golden West College where he is a full-time faculty member. Sergeant Richard Ashby is a 20-year veteran of the Santa Ana Police Department and has focused the majority of his career in the area of gang enforcement. He is a court recognized gang expert and was assigned to the Santa Ana gang detail for twelve years. Rick served as the SAPD Gang Homicide supervisor and supervised the SAPD Graffiti Task Force. Together, Derrick and Rick co-authored the text, "Gang Investigations, A Street Cop's Guide." A copy of this book will be given to each student and is included in the fees.

# ***GANG AWARENESS UPDATE***

**August 24, 2010**  
(8 HOURS)

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This class instructs students in gang suppression techniques, methods of identifying and documenting street gangs, understanding the relationship between gangs and their effect on local crime, and the importance of providing expert testimony in gang related cases. The class also emphasizes the importance of interfacing with County Probation, State Parole, and other law-enforcement agencies when conducting gang investigations. The instructors are court-recognized experts in gang sub-culture, gang homicide investigations, and gang suppression techniques. Both instructors are currently assigned to Santa Ana Police Department's Gang Unit.

# ***ADVANCED INTERVIEW AND INTERROGATION***

**September 23, 2010**

*(8 HOURS)*

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This class is designed to teach patrol officers and investigators the skills necessary to conduct successful interviews and interrogations. Experienced detectives instruct students on the mechanics of questioning, proper interview sequencing, and specific escalation techniques that are designed to smoothly transition into the interrogation from the opening interview. Furthermore, the instructors cover State and Federal laws, as well as the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 14<sup>th</sup> Amendments of the United States Constitution. These detectives assigned to various assignments within the Investigations Bureau, have interviewed hundreds of suspects and have accomplished success soliciting information and confessions in several high profile cases.

# ***OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING INVESTIGATIONS***

**October 27, 2010**  
(8 HOURS)

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This class is designed to provide police officers and field supervisors with a basic understanding of the dynamics of Officer Involved Shootings and the resulting investigations. Course topics include the psychological and physiological impact on officers involved in a shooting and an overview of the investigative procedures. Interactive teaching techniques are used to stimulate discussion and to involve students in problem-solving exercises. The instructor, Cmdr. Doug McGeachy, formerly a SWAT Team member and a Professional Standards Inspector possesses an extensive knowledge of tactics, OIS investigations, and criminal street gangs. While working a gang suppression assignment, Cmdr. McGeachy was shot, which left him seriously wounded and ultimately having to fight for his life. Cmdr. McGeachy uses this experience to teach the course and better prepare officers to handle similar incidents in their jurisdictions.

# ***REPORT WRITING FOR PATROL***

**October 14, 2010**  
(8 HOURS)

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

Report Writing for Patrol Officers has been designed to improve basic report writing skills. Students will learn the importance of utilizing a systematic approach to obtain information and document an incident. The class emphasizes general report writing skills and techniques officers may use to improve spelling, grammar, and punctuation. Students will have an opportunity to participate in practical application scenarios. The scenarios are designed to improve students' report writing through the collection of information, recording critical elements, and documenting events in chronological order.

# ***SEARCH WARRANTS FOR INVESTIGATORS***

**September 1, 2010**  
(8 HOURS)

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This course is designed to teach students the proper method for writing a search warrant. In addition, students will learn why and when to obtain a search warrant in order to preserve evidence and to help ensure a successful prosecution. The class covers the basic legal requirements of the search warrant itself, the affidavit, and the return of the warrant. Students will also learn about different types of search warrants including the "Hobbs," "Sneak and Peek," "Steagald," "Anticipatory," and "Thompson." Each student will be provided with a compact disc containing templates and samples of the different types of search warrants. Students should bring to class a list of their experience and training, as they will be provided an opportunity to document their expertise as part of the course.

# ***FIRST AID/CPR REFRESHER***

**September 28/November 9, 2010**

**(8 HOURS)**

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This course meets state training mandates for First Aid and CPR. It is designed for sworn and civilian police personnel who require certification. The purpose of this course is to:

- Provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide basic care for breathing and cardiac emergencies for adults, children, and infants.
- Provide participants the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and respond with basic care for injuries and sudden illnesses.
- Educate and promote awareness of communicable diseases.

Instruction is through lecture and practical application exercises. All instructors are certified by the American Red Cross.

Upon successful course completion, each participant will receive an American Red Cross Universal Certificate. This includes a Standard First Aid certification that is valid for 3 years as well as an Adult / Child / Infant CPR certification that is valid for 1 year.

# **ARREST & CONTROL TECHNIQUES**

**December 1, 2010**  
(8 HOURS)

**The Orange County Peace Officers Association is committed to supporting quality law enforcement training. As a result of their sponsorship, this course is free for all participants.**

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This eight-hour arrest and control course is intended exclusively for law enforcement and fire personnel. This course is instructed by experts in multiple disciplines, including: Muay Thai, Karate, Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu, Boxing, Greco Roman and Freestyle Wrestling.

The curriculum includes:

- Use of Force legal considerations
- Pugilistic techniques
- Defense against the takedown
- Ground control techniques

This is a physically demanding course and all participants should be in good physical condition. No light or restricted duty personnel will be allowed to participate. All students attending this course, whether on or off-duty, must complete and sign a waiver of liability prior to participation in the class.

The following equipment is required: Sweat pants and an extra shirt, also a duty belt without firearms and ammunition. Mat shoes are recommended, but not required. Mouth guards are mandatory and will be provided the day of the course.

# ***F.B.I. TACTICAL BREACHER COURSE***

*(16 hours)*

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

This course will provide the student with the training and experience to safely and successfully breach doors and windows when serving arrest and search warrants. A large portion of the course will be spent on practical applications, using the various tools and equipment designed for breaching operations. Such breaching techniques and tools include:

- Ballistic shotgun breaching, hydraulic tools, halogen tools and rams, cut saw, exothermic cutting (torch), bolt cutters, vehicle pulls, as well as vehicle window breaching techniques.

Students will perform practical applications to demonstrate their proficiency on breaching metal security doors, residential and commercial doors, windows, deadbolts, and lock/bolt mechanisms. The instructors are Subject Matter Experts from the F.B.I. and the Santa Ana Police Department. This course is designed for personnel assigned to tactical teams and investigators involved in high-risk entries and warrant service. Students who successfully complete the course will receive an F.B.I. certificate of completion, as well as P.O.S.T. certification.

# ***RAPID DEPLOYMENT FOR THE FIRST RESPONDER***

**July 21, 2010**

**(9 HOURS)**

*Presented in conjunction with Santa Ana College*

Students will have the opportunity to learn various tactics and strategies to be used in life threatening situations where delayed deployment may result in death or serious bodily injury to innocent persons. This 9-hour course consists of both lecture and practical application. The lecture portion provides an overview of team dynamics, team movement, room clearing, and searching. Additionally, rescues, evacuations, and other skills for addressing an immediate threat are covered. A major portion of the time will be spent in practical applications emphasizing safety, target recognition, team movement, and force on force scenarios. Simunition weapons and marking cartridges will be utilized during the practical application portion of this course.
