

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR-MOTOR SWEEPERDEFINITION

Under general supervision, operates a motor sweeper to clean streets, gutters, alleys and parking lots in the City and performs other related duties as required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO

Operates a motor sweeper during the day, night, or weekend shift and sweeps streets, alleys and gutters on assigned routes. Selects effective and efficient methods to cover assigned area. Performs routine maintenance on the motor sweeper, such as cleaning, gassing, checking oil and water, and broom adjustments. Checks for broom and chain wear and reports all mechanical problems or deficiencies to the maintenance garage. Performs minor field maintenance as required. Prepares and maintains records as required. Operates overhead loaders, container trucks and other equipment, which requires a B license on an occasional basis. Performs other functions as assigned.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS

Employees in this class are responsible for the safe and efficient operation of motorized street sweeping equipment during either the weekend, day, or night shift as required. The equipment operation requires considerable manipulative skill as well as constant attention to the safety of personnel and property. Routes are assigned by the supervisor.

RECOMMENDED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education and experience equivalent to completion of tenth grade and two years experience in the operation of equipment such as heavy duty trucks, motor sweepers or similar vehicles, or two years experience at the semiskilled level (Maintenance Worker II) with the City of Santa Ana, or any other combination of education and experience which provides the following knowledge, skills and abilities: Knowledge of principles and techniques of motor sweeping operations, City safety practices as they related to sweeper operations, streets and City geography. Skills in the operation of motor sweepers and related equipment, general and routine vehicle equipment maintenance. Ability to communicate effectively with the public.

Special Requirement: Possession and retention of a valid Class B California driver's license throughout tenure in this classification.
