

WATER METER REPAIRER II

DEFINITION

Under general supervision, performs skilled mechanical work in the installation, maintenance, repair and testing of a wide variety of water meters and related equipment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO

Disassembles, cleans, overhauls, reassembles, and tests a wide variety of water meters and related equipment. Drives a service truck on an assigned route to install or remove, inspect, test, adjust and repair meters. Disassembles meters and inspects parts, reconditioning, repairing or replacing those found to be worn or defective. Cleans and lubricates moving parts. Reassembles meters and tests and adjusts for required history records. Maintains inventory control records. Schedules all large meter tests and orders parts, tools, and supplies. Interprets statistical reports generated by meter profile recorder. Makes independent decisions based on available data. Performs other functions as assigned.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS

The Water Meter Repairer II is a journey level position in the Water Meter Repairers' Career Ladder in the Water Quality and measurement section of the Water Resources Division. Incumbents perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in the shop and field in cleaning, repairing, maintaining and testing water meters.

RECOMMENDED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Three years experience as a Water Meter Repairer I.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Working knowledge of: simple hydraulics. The practices, methods, tools, and equipment used in the installation, repair and testing of water meters.

Skill in: the use and care of hand and power tools and equipment appropriate to the work.

Ability to: diagnose defects in water metering equipment and to determine proper corrective measures; operate a computer terminal to maintain, input, and access detailed repair and service records; deal tactfully with the general public.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession and retention of a California Class "C" driver's license throughout tenure in this classification is a condition of employment.
