

WHY RECYCLE? IT'S STATE LAW!

Mandatory Commercial and Multi-Family Recycling – AB341

The California legislature passed Assembly Bill 341 (AB341) making it mandatory that businesses and multi-family (apartment and condominium) complexes have a recycling program beginning July 1, 2012.

The City of Santa Ana is required to inform businesses and multi-family complexes about the recycling requirement and to track the level of recycling within this sector. The City is also required to report each year to the State on the success of these programs.

What does this mean for your business or complex?

Businesses generating four cubic yards or more of waste on a weekly basis and multi-family properties with five or more units are required to recycle. In many cases, recycling programs can save you money. Now is the time to determine the best recycling program for your operation and possibly reduce your trash bill.
