



Santa Ana Youth (SAY) Employment



Congratulations on taking the first step in the process of getting a job with the Santa Ana Youth (SAY) Employment Program!

The City of Santa Ana has allocated a portion of Cannabis Public Benefit funds and Community Development Block Grant funds to operate the Santa Ana Youth (SAY) Employment program. The SAY Employment Program administered by the Santa Ana WORK Center will provide paid work experience to 120 youth ages 16-21 years old. Youth must complete the online application and upload the required documents. **We strongly encourage you to complete the application as soon as possible. Jobs are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Our Program is targeting low-income youth impacted by Covid-19. Selected participants will work 20 hours per week. If you are under 18, you **must** submit with the application a **Request for Work Permit** and have your parent or guardian sign it.

The selection process is first-come, first-served, and meet the following criteria:

- Live in Santa Ana
- Youth must be 16 to 21 years of age.
- Be a citizen of the United States or have legal permission to work in the United States.
- Must be income eligible.
- Individual or family must have been affected by Covid-19
- Must complete an online application and provide required documentation.

<input type="radio"/> Birth Certificate	
<input type="radio"/> Family Income or personal income (if independent of parents) for the last 6 months	3 paystubs or a current pay stub that has the Year To Date on it, social security benefits, proof of governmental assistance, or state disability, etc.
