SAFE ROUTE TO SCHOOL ENHANCEMENTS FOR SEPULVEDA ELEMENTARY
June 2020 – Feb 2021

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- The project location is along Civic Center Boulevard from Broadway to Santiago connecting Downtown Santa Ana via the Lacy, Logan, and French Park neighborhoods to the Santa Ana Regional Transportation Center (SARTC).
- The improvement consists of four neighborhood traffic circles/mini roundabouts with curb bulb-out extensions at the intersections of Minter Street, Lacy Street, Garfield Street, and Poinsettia Street. These intersections will also include new irrigation and landscaping.
- Safety and aesthetic features include 7 new curb bulb-out extension intersections, 53 new curb ramps, 24 shortened crosswalks, and a new crossing at French Street.

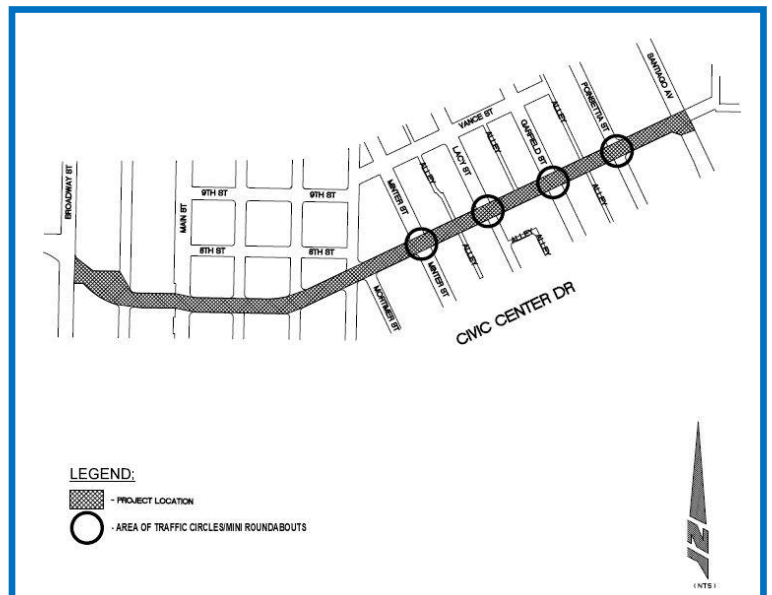
