### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

#### Hazard Avenue from Santa Ana River to Bristol Street

- Construct raised concrete medians as protection for new bicycle lanes on Hazard Ave from Euclid Street to West Street
- Install bike route on Hazard Ave from West St to Harbor Blvd by a new striping
- Reconfigure striping to one travel lane in both directions for cars while retaining on-street parking
- Retain a center lane for vehicles making turns

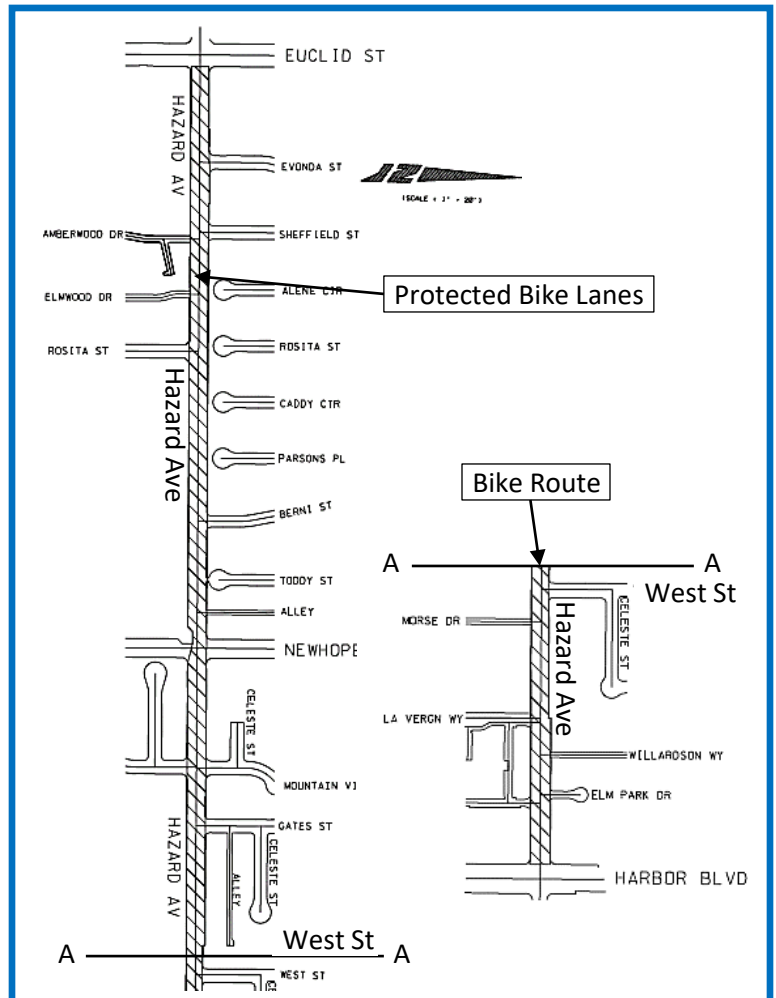
